

Product Information, Warranty & Navigation Update Instructions

Congratulations!

Thank you for purchasing a Zenec device. You may not know this but Zenec is Germany's largest in-car navigation and multimedia brand and are committed to supplying products of an extremely high standard with the latest technology. We are confident that you will be extremely happy with your purchase of a Zenec device, however we would like to inform you about some important information that will ensure it performs to its maximum potential.

Warranty Information

The standard warranty on your Zenec device is a 3 Year back to base warranty against manufacturing defects. This covers parts and labour, so if you experience a problem with your device, please contact your reseller for assistance. Proof of purchase and serial number will be required for any warranty or support, so please keep this information in a safe place. Navigation, Software and Bluetooth updates may be released periodically on our website. Performing these updates is the responsibility of the end user.

Software Updates

Software updates for your Zenec device are simple and user friendly, so to ensure that it performs to its maximum potential, please check our website occasionally to see if there are any updates available for your device. Due to rapid changes in mobile phone technology, updates for the Parrot Bluetooth system on your device are released regularly to ensure this feature of your device functions correctly.

Navigation Updates

Every year new roads are built, existing ones are altered and speed limits are changed so regular map updates are released to ensure you have the most up to date information at your fingertips when driving. This device comes with a 1 year latest map guarantee using the Naviextras Toolbox. Enclosed is documentation that explains how you can ensure that your device is as up to date as possible. If you would like to purchase additional updates once this 1 year period expires you may do so through the Naviextras Toolbox.

Navigation Update

The Latest Map Guarantee ensures that you are able to download the latest map data over the Naviextras update server for 1 year after the device is installed. Your device has left our Australian Warehouse with an SD card that has the latest Navigation Content and Software available at that time. Below you will find instructions on how you can go about updating your Zenec Device.

What you need?


- **PC or Notebook** with Windows XP (Service Pack 2) or higher and equipped with a SD Card Port or an SD-USB adapter.
- **SD Card** as found in your Zenec device (if your SD card is a micro, an adapter is included in the box).
- **Naviextras Toolbox Software.** The latest version can be found on our website – www.zenec.com.au. You will find it under your device, “Support and Download” tab, then “Naviextras” tab.
- **Active Internet Connection.** Naviextras Toolbox requires a working broadband internet connection.

Important Information


- **Each Navigation license is tied to a specific SD card. Please do not attempt to modify or add anything to the navigation content on the SD card. Modified SD cards may be unrecoverable, in which case a replacement SD card with a new navigation license will need to be purchased by the end user.**
- If you receive a “Latest Map Guarantee” message on your device when you enter the navigation, please tick the box “Don’t show again” and “Dismiss”. Your device has left our warehouse with the latest available content already loaded on your SD card.
- Once you have downloaded and installed Naviextras Toolbox you will need to create a user account. When creating a user account you need to nominate your device. Please select the model of your device. ie Z-N626
- **VERY IMPORTANT:- After you successfully login to Naviextras Toolbox, you will be prompted to back up the information on your SD Card. Please DO NOT skip this step. If there is a problem with installing or updating your device, the backup will be required to restore your device. If a backup is not available, your device will need to be sent back to our Service Department and a new SD Card with a new license will need to be issued at your cost.**
- Please follow the Instructions overleaf carefully and **DO NOT** install any content other than Australian or New Zealand.

Naviextras Toolbox Instructions

1. Launch Naviextras Toolbox and login.
2. If you are prompted to install the latest version of Naviextras please do so before proceeding.
3. Plug in your SD Card.
4. If you are asked to login, please enter your registration details or register your details now.
5. If Updates are available the button on the left of the screen will say **UPDATES** as indicated by **A**.



6. Press the **Updates** button and the below screen will display. If there are “packages to install” press **Install** as indicated by **B**. If, however, you receive a notice saying “Your device is up-to-date”, there are no updates currently available for your device. You can periodically check our website, www.zenec.com.au, or join our social media to be informed when new updates are released.



7. If you get a pop-up asking you do back-up, do not do this at this stage. This can be done later.
8. Once complete, shut down naviextras Toolbox, return to your car and insert your SD Card back into your device. **NOTE:** Your device may need to receive a GPS signal before the Navigation starts to function properly.
