

#### 1. LOG-IN

To access your account, simply go to our website <a href="www.BetterChinese.com">www.BetterChinese.com</a>. Click on the "My Online Lessons Login" drop-down menu and select "Online Learning System" to log-in.



a unique ID.




Use the drop-down menu to toggle between each of your classes. If you do not have this feature, please contact your sales manager.



### 2. NAVIGATION (Dashboard)

Once you have logged in successfully, you will see your Dashboard



#### **MY RECORD**

- Current Lesson
- **Students:** Total number of students in your class. Click "View" to manage your class roster, student records and assignments
- Assignments: See the total number of assignments. Click "View" to see the list.
- Messages: View and post messages to your class
- Recent Activities
- Courses Planned: Number of courses planned

### 3. LESSONS (Index)

Within the "Lessons" tab in the menu bar, you'll find all of the lessons from the Better Chinese's series that you are subscribed to (i.e. My First Chinese Words). Mouse over the Lesson number to view the lesson name. Click on it to enter the lesson.





The checkmark represents a score of 75% or below was achieved in the homework section.



The star represents a score above 75% on the homework section.



### **Individual Lesson Components**

Each lesson contains a variety of components.


- Lessons: Animation of the lesson text
- Exercise: Each My First Chinese Words lesson includes 3 exercises
- Magical Chinese: Animations that depict how Chinese characters evolved from pictographs
- Fun Story: A story related to the lesson
- Songs/Rhymes: Only for the younger series.
- Homework: 20 multiple choice questions focused on reading and listening skills
- Projects: 5 exercises focused primarily on character writing and speaking
- Read-Along (Only for My First Chinese Words): Students practice reading the outloud



Depending on the size of your screen, part of the exercise image may be cut-off. Expand your view mode to full screen in order to see everything.

On a PC, click on the F11 to switch to the full-screen mode

 On a Mac, switch into full-screen mode by clicking on the arrow in the top righthand corner of the screen

#### 4. TOOLS

The language tool section includes a voice recorder, a character writing pad and a composition tool to help hone your character writing, speaking and typing skills.






#### Voice Recorder

Practice speaking Chinese and play back your recording to check your pronunciation. Saved recordings are stored in the "RECORDS" area on the "TOOLS" page.



- Check your mic setting if no sound is being recorded



#### SAVE RECORDING

- · Click the red button in the middle to start recording and press it again to stop.
- · Click "Play" to play
- · Click "Save" to save



### Writing Pad

Practice writing Chinese characters on the Writing Pad. Save your work and see if your stroke order and placement are correct.





#### Composition

Practice typing in Chinese with pinyin with the composition tool. Choose which Chinese keyboards you would like to use in the "Settings" area of your computer.




#### E-Cards

#### 5. ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT

Access your account settings and subscriptions through this interface. Now you have a more efficient way to keep track of your subscriptions.




#### ACCOUNT MANAGER

In the subscriptions section, you will be able to see what subscriptions you have purchased. Simply click "Try" to access other subscriptions that you might be interested in on a complimentary basis for 30-days. (Note: you will only be able to try a subscription for free once)




#### **TRY OR BUY**

Simply click to get a 30 day trial of any subscription. Click "Buy" to renew or purchase a subscription.



#### 6. COMPOSE MESSAGES

You can write notes to individual students and/or the whole class. Students will see these messages on the Message Board.



Be sure to click "Post" once. Otherwise, you will end up with more than one copy of the post.




#### 7. CREATE ASSIGNMENTS

You can assign lesson modules, story modules, songs, homework, projects, read-along, writing pad, and voice recorders where available. Students will receive their assignments in their dashboard. Click on the Assign button on the left hand teacher resources menu.



a. Assign a Task. The available tasks for assignment would be shown in the dropdown menu. Select the task and click "Assign" when finished. "Homework" problem sets includes 20 questions focused on listening and reading skills related to the lesson. The "Project" problem sets includes 5 questions focused on character writing, read-aloud passages, and creative speaking exercises.




**Select Receiving Students.** Scroll below to where all the students are listed from the class roster. There you can receive choose who should receive the assignment and create differentiated instructions. Click "Submit" when you are finished.

Your students will now see the new assignment posted on the bulletin board on their dashboard. Be sure to remind them that they <u>MUST</u> click on the assignment link on the message board in order for you to receive their answers. It is the only way for the system to link their work to a specific assignment.




- **b.** Assign Writing Pad & Voice Recorder: You can use these tools to flexibly create "writing" or "oral" assignments. You must include your instructions in the message box. For example, ask your students to "Introduce yourself in Chinese." You can only assign one Chinese character at a time through the character writing tool.
- c. Viewing Your Assignment: Both you and your students will be able to view these assignments on the Message Board. Note: in order for you to view and grade the assignment, your students must submit their homework first.



#### 8. RETRIEVE ASSIGNMENTS

Our system will automatically grade assignments labeled as "Homework." You can retrieve the student results, such as time spent, access time, audio recording and writing.


a. Retrieve Specific Assignments: If you want to see the last assignment, just click on the "Last Assignment Completion" % on the dashboard page. If you want to retrieve a specific previous assignment, click on the number link next to "Assignments."




**b. View Assignment Results:** You click on the <u>%</u> to see the completion rate and click on Detailed Report or Report to see individual students' records or scores.



**c. Grading Assignments:** *Homework* modules are automatically graded by our system. For projects and our tools section (*Composition and Voice Recorder*), you can click on username links to see the student's work.









#### 9. TRACK STUDENT PROGRESS
