



# DON'T FORGET!

## TO FILE YOUR HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION

As part of our continued commitment to serve you as a valued customer, we would like to remind you that from January 1st to April 30th, you can file for the General Homestead Exemption in order to qualify for lower taxes for the property that you own and occupy.

Sometime this month, you should receive the Residential Homestead Exemption Application from the appropriate appraisal district. You must complete and sign this form and mail back to the appraisal district no later than April 30th to receive your exemption for this year.

If you do not receive your application form, you may contact the appropriate appraisal district for your property or visit their website. Contact information for our area appraisal districts is as follows:
